

# Safety First

Never enter private, personal,  
proprietary, or patron data into  
any AI system\*!

*(\*unless your IT department said it's OK)*



# Protecting Your Data

- Unprotected online data can be ingested for AI training
- Even protected data may be sold or transferred to an AI provider
- Be aware of AI and data policies of providers



# Conversation "Re-use"

- Any chat with an AI can be re-used by the AI provider for training future AI models.
- Conversational data could then be preserved in the AI's knowledge.



# Context Connections

- Be careful "connecting" AI to personal or library data sources: files, cameras, etc.
